

RELIGIOUS STUDIES DEGREE CHECKLIST

~ FOR STUDENTS BEGINNING THE PROGRAM

PRIOR TO FALL 2009

ORDINARY BA: 90 CREDITS

- ❑ 24 General Education credits (from Humanities, Natural Science, and Social Science, including a minimum of six credits in each of Humanities, Natural Science and Social Science)
- ❑ at least 18 credits outside the major
- ❑ at least 30 credits from Religious Studies
- ❑ at least 12 Religious Studies credits at the 3000 level or above, with another 6 credits at the 3000 level or above outside the major
- ❑ Religious Studies courses must include AP/HUMA 2800 (crosslisted as AP/SOSC 2600) or AP/HUMA 3803 and 3804

HONOURS BA: 120 CREDITS

- ❑ 24 General Education credits (from Humanities, Natural Science, and Social Science, including a minimum of six credits in each of Humanities, Natural Science and Social Science)
- ❑ at least 18 credits outside the major
- ❑ at least 42 credits from Religious Studies
- ❑ at least 12 Religious Studies credits at the 3000 level or above
- ❑ at least 12 Religious Studies credits at the 4000 level, with another 6 credits at the 4000 level outside the major
- ❑ Religious Studies courses must include AP/HUMA 2800 (crosslisted as AP/SOSC 2600) or AP/HUMA 3803 and 3804

SPECIALIZED HONOURS BA: 120 CREDITS

All requirements for the Honours BA along with 12 additional Religious Studies credits.

HONOURS DOUBLE MAJOR INTERDISCIPLINARY (LINKED) BA PROGRAM: 120 CREDITS

All requirements for the Honours BA except: students must take at least 36 credits in Religious Studies and at least 36 credits in the interdisciplinary program, and the 18 credits at the 4000 level must include 12 credits in Religious Studies and 6 credits in the interdisciplinary program.

HONOURS MINOR BA: 120 CREDITS

- ❑ at least 30 Religious Studies courses, including AP/HUMA 2800 (crosslisted as AP/SOSC 2600) or AP/HUMA 3803 and 3804
- ❑ at least 6 Religious Studies credits at the 4000 level

NOTE: For purposes of meeting programme requirements, all Foundations courses will count as 6 credits towards the major. In addition, students are allowed to count only one 1000-level course toward either their major or minor. Up to 12 credits in language courses may be counted towards the Religious Studies degree.
